Shinai = Bamboo Sword



Tenugui  
= Japanese Thin Towel

under a mask,  
use for gathering up hair, and for stopping sweat

## Poses and Wearable Poses



### 01 Seigan-No-Kamae

Kamae is a basic stance. This is the most basic posture , also called chudan-no-kamae (middle stance).

It provides a balance between attacking and defensive techniques.



### 02 Men-Uchikomi-01

Beginning to defeat toward rivals Men



### 03 Men-Uchikomi-02

Moment to strike toward Men of rival



### 04 Bogyo = Defense



### 05 Tsuba-Zeriai

Situation that catch the bamboo sword (Shinai) which struck at the sword like brim (Tsuba).

Zeriai = Seriai = Competition



### 06 Seiza

Sitting straight

Basic Japanese way of sitting
